Greetings, CASA Friends!

With another successful year in the books we are so thankful for all the great things that happened at Tulsa CASA in 2017. We helped more children than ever and eclipsed 200 cases served (204, to be exact) for the first time in our organization's history! "Thank you" does not quite express the depth of our gratitude for your generous and continued support over these past 33 years. Nonetheless—thank you, thank you, thank you.

If I had to sum up 2017 in one word it would be "growth." Last year we experienced tremendous growth in the number of cases served (+16%), children served (+17%) and in the number of volunteers serving on cases (+10%). We also saw growth in the number of court dockets we serve. Tulsa CASA is now providing trained advocates on 6 dockets including the Safe Babies and the Dually Adjudicated dockets. The Safe Babies Court Team approach addresses the special needs of babies in an expeditious manner utilizing "Baby CASAs" and the CASAs on our Dually Adjudicated docket provide advocacy to foster youth with delinquency charges. Finally, we experienced physical growth in our office space this year which will allow us to accommodate much needed growth among our staff this coming year.

Despite the tremendous growth we've experienced, there are still nearly 1,500 children in Tulsa County who could benefit from the appointment of a CASA on their case. Our CASA volunteers are a dedicated group who give tirelessly of their time and expertise for the benefit of these children. Want to learn more about this incredible volunteer opportunity? 

2017 Program Statistics




Tulsa CASA Mission

2017 Tulsa CASA Balance Sheet




