Hello!

2018 was a big year for Tulsa CASA. We advocated for more than 400 children and served more cases than ever in our organization's history! "Thank you" does not quite express the depth of our gratitude for your generous and continued support over these past 34 years. Nonetheless—thank you!

Looking back on 2018, we can describe it as a year of tremendous growth. Last year we experienced increases in the number of cases served (+9%), children served (+13%) and in the number of volunteers who served on cases (+14%). We also saw growth in the number of court dockets we serve. Tulsa CASA is now providing trained advocates on seven dockets including two Safe Babies and the Dually Adjudicated dockets. The Safe Babies Court Team approach addresses the special needs of children aged zero to three in an expeditious manner utilizing "Baby CASAs," and the CASAs on our Dually Adjudicated docket provide advocacy to foster youth with delinquency charges.

Despite the remarkable growth we've experienced, there are still over 1,200 children in Tulsa County who could benefit from the appointment of a CASA on their case. Our CASA volunteers are a dedicated group who give tirelessly of their time and expertise for the benefit of these children. Want to learn more about this incredible volunteer opportunity? 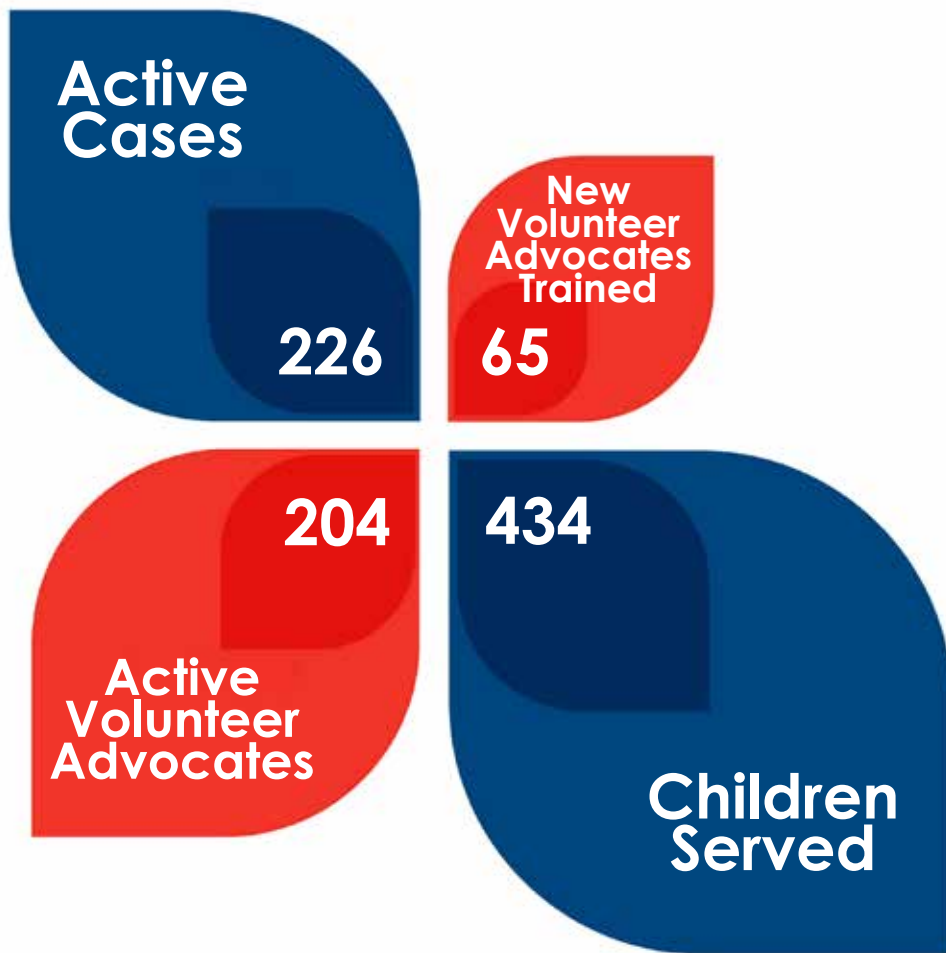

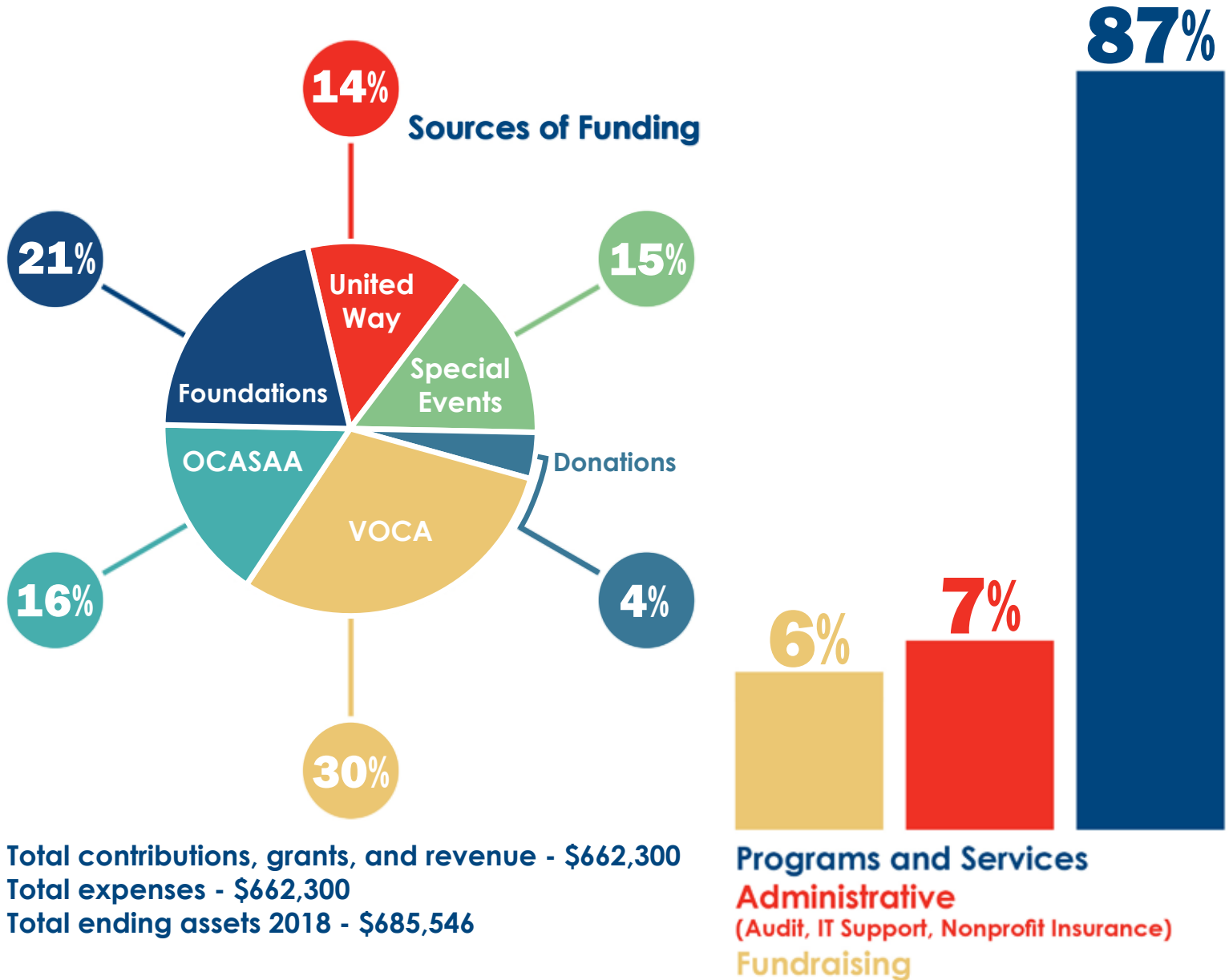

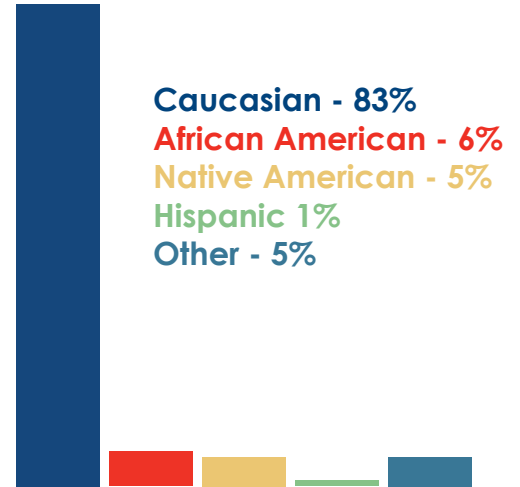
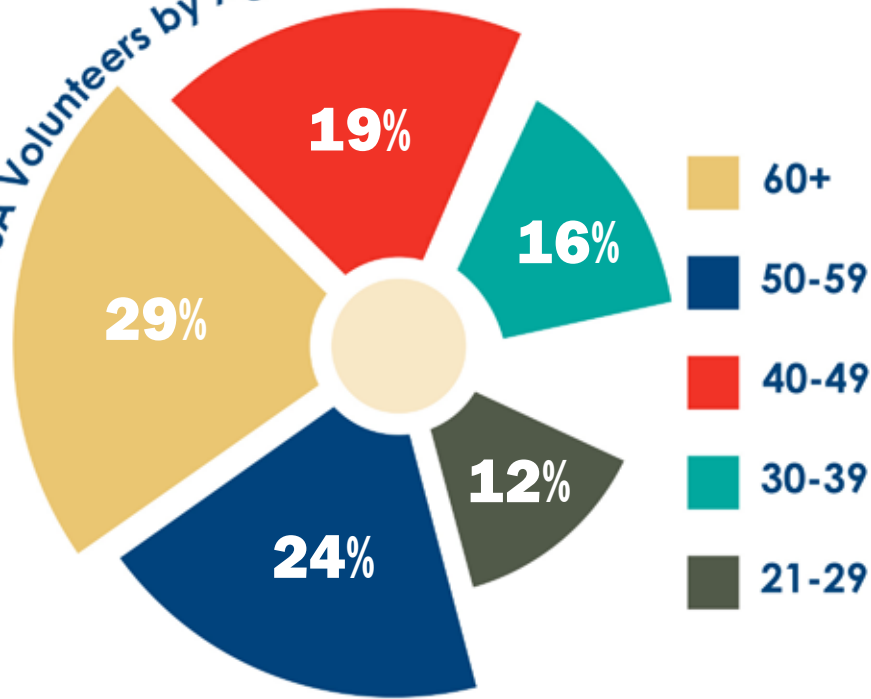

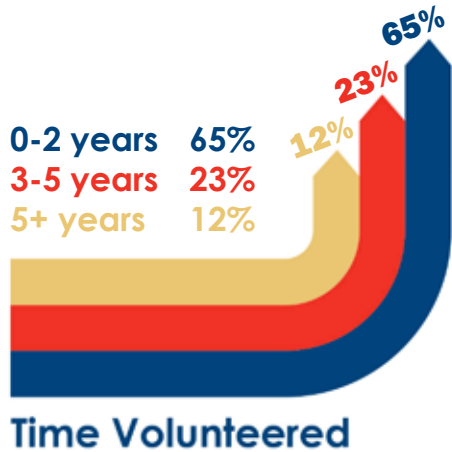
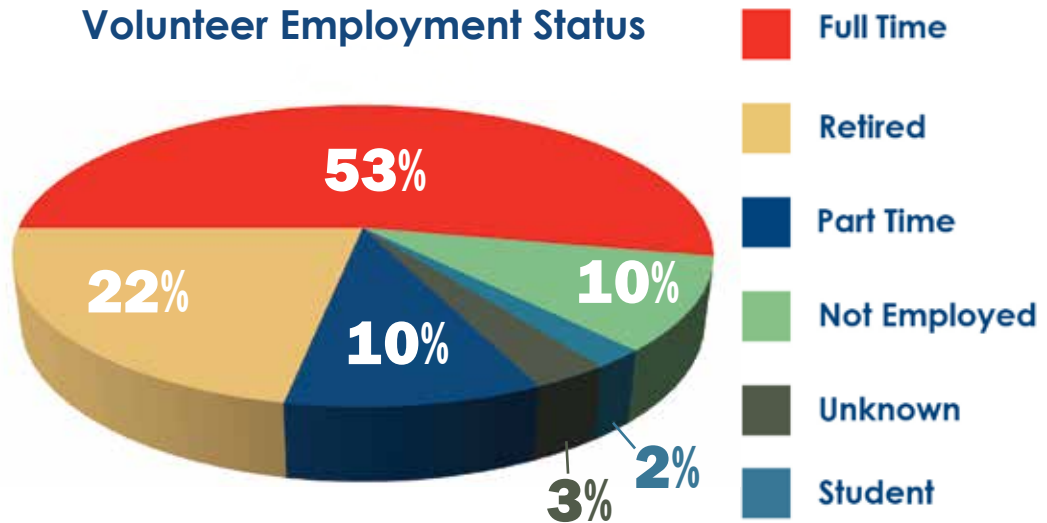

Volunteer Employment Status

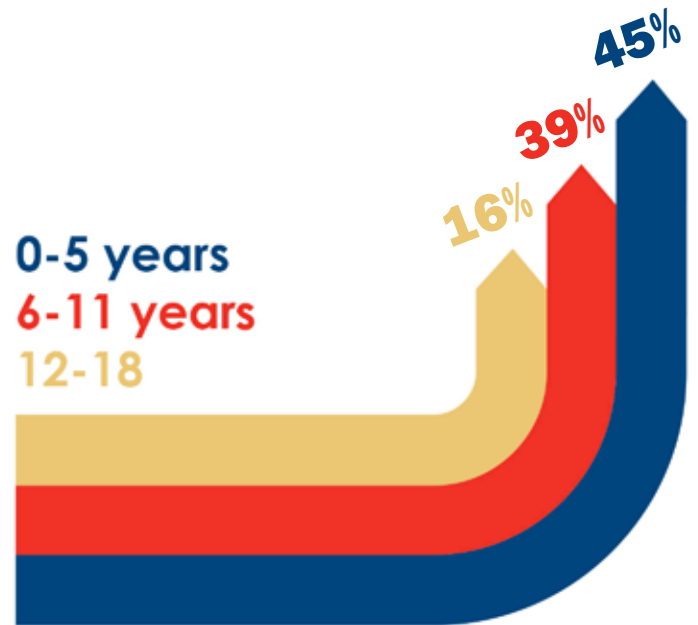




2018 Demographics of CASA Children

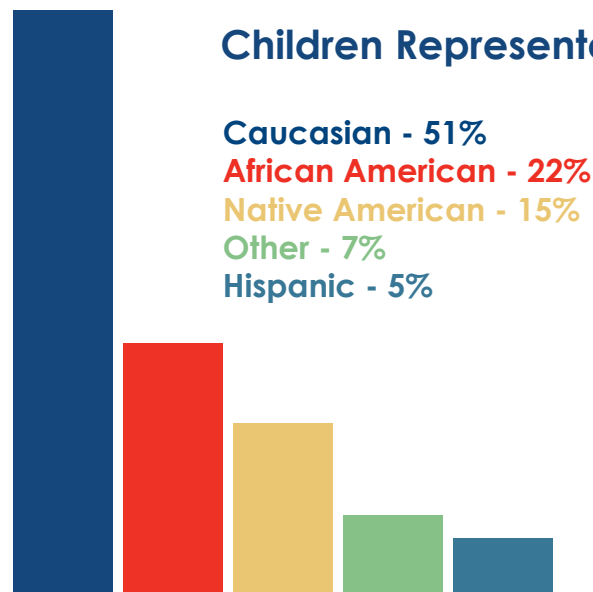
